The Maricopa County Special Health Care District (“District”) d.b.a. Maricopa Integrated Health System (MIHS) is hereby issuing Addendum #2 to the Request for Proposals which requested sealed proposals from qualified Proposers to provide surgical implantable devices for Spinal Surgery and Biological products to include anterior cervical system, posterior cervical system, lumbar/thoracic system, and interbody devices.

Pursuant to the Procurement Code Clause HS-305, Paragraph A(3), this Addendum Two will furnish to other Respondents information given to one Respondent to assist the other Respondents in submitting their responses.

1.	What Group Purchasing Organizations (GPOs) is MIHS a member of?
MIHS is currently participates in a GPO with Broadlane, Inc.	

2.	Is MIHS planning on limiting their vendors; i.e. a single source, dual source, tri –source, etc...?
At this time it is our intent to award to two vendors; however, MIHS reserves the right to award only one contract or several based upon the Proposal(s) most advantageous to the Maricopa Integrated Health System, price and other factors considered.	

3.	Can you please help clarify the “Work Statement Requirements” and attachment F?
The Work Statement contained in this particular RFP is not a standard ‘Scope of Work’ format that may be found in most RFP documents. The Work Statement in this case will serve as ‘Additional Terms and Conditions’ in the resultant awarded Contract.	

4.	How is tissue (crushed cancellous bone chips, DBM, putty, ACF spacers) being contracted and/or consigned?
Tissue is currently being provided to MIHS under contract by other vendors and is not considered a part of this Request for Proposal.	

5.	I need some clarification on the terms and conditions. Which part of the RFP represents the T&C’s that will be agreed upon? Also, is it possible to receive them in a Word document so we can redline the language if necessary?
The Terms and Conditions will be comprised of two separate parts of this RFP under the Contract General Provisions and the Work Statement. A word version of the Work Statement Provisions will be provided through a Word document format of the RFP document as a separate attachment.
