DENTAL COVERAGE EMERGENCY DENTAL BENEFIT



WHAT IS IT?

In 2017 the Arizona Legislature enacted a policy that added Adult emergency dental services and extractions up to \$1000 as covered benefits, effective August 9, 2017

WHAT'S COVERED?

- Crowns on root canal treated teeth
- General anesthesia when medically necessary
- Dentures and partial dentures are not covered
- Emergency exams
- Extractions
- Root canals
- Tooth colored fillings due to broken front teeth
